STAFF RECOMMENDATION:


Staff has concluded that the request is appropriate and recommends approval of the grant application and to accept the proposed grant funding and put into the appropriate budget lines of the police department.



BACKGROUND DISCUSSION:

The West Jordan Police Department is applying for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) from the U.S. Department of Justice in the amount of \$30,785.00.

If awarded, West Jordan will use the funds allocated by the 2016 JAG grant to purchase a mobile camera trailer. Additional costs for the equipment in excess of the funds from this grant will be paid for by the City of West Jordan. The grant funds for this project will be used to enhance our law enforcement presence and response in large gatherings and investigations, in an effort to deter gun violence and other crimes. The evidence gathered from these cameras will be used as evidence in the prosecution of any crimes that are caught on these cameras. The cameras will add a level of technology we don't currently have and aid us in the deterrence of gun violence and crimes involving gun theft.

West Jordan Police has received four quotes for mobile camera trailers from two different companies and is working on obtaining other quotes. West Jordan has not decided which company we will go with at this time. The quotes we have received are outlined in the program narrative. West Jordan Police Department will evaluate these quotes and any other that come in for quality of product and price points.

Requirements of this grant include making a copy of the grant application available to the governing body, or organization designated by that body, not less than thirty days before the Bureau of Justice Assistance accepts the application, and holding a public hearing allowing the general public to comment on the recommendations.

A posted copy of the application was made available to the governing body and for public review on July 5, 2016, in the City Clerk's Office, and also on the City's website. In addition, on July 5, 2016, a notice of public hearing to be held August 10, 2016, was advertised in local newspapers.



The West Jordan Police Department has 111 sworn officers and 43 civilian employees and volunteers. West Jordan City has a population of nearly 111,000 people. The city hosts several large events throughout the year with thousands of people attending the events. Our goal with the Edward Byrne Memorial Grant, for fiscal years 2016, is to purchase a portable camera trailer. These cameras would be used during large gatherings in the city, as a visual deterrent to those intending harm to others, and to aid in the investigations involving gun theft and violence.

Program Narrative

During the past several years gun violence has been an ongoing problem in our country. Mass shootings and active gunman incidents are a constant concern for law enforcement communities all over the country.

West Jordan City is the fourth largest city in the State of Utah. It is a suburb of Salt Lake City and sits on the west side of Salt Lake valley. West Jordan has a population of approximately 111,000 residents. The city hosts several events throughout the year including the Western Stampede Rodeo, a carnival at Veterans Memorial Park, Independence Day Parade, theater events, Days of Hope Car Show, Library days, an endurocross and several other events.

The West Jordan Police Department is very mindful of its obligation and duty to keep residents safe and provide a safe atmosphere for the events that occur in the city. We understand the accountability we have to each other, our profession and the public. We want to be courageous guardians of life, liberty, and property. With these goals in mind and the ongoing gun violence in our country, our intention is to purchase surveillance equipment that will allow us to:

- Deter gun crimes by the mere sight of security cameras at an event.
- Live video access at major events to scan the crowd for problems.
- More organized response to any particular problem as officers can be directed to respond to a certain area.
- The ability to deploy cameras at local gun manufacturing sites if there is a security concern.

The FY 2016 JAG application will be on the agenda for the West Jordan City Council meeting on August 10, 2016, when citizens will be given the opportunity to make comments. A verification notice of the completion of the 30 day period necessary for review by the governing body and public hearing will be sent to the program manager.
