**A PROCLAMATION DECLARING
APRIL 21-26, 2014 AS CDBG WEEK
IN THE CITY OF WEST JORDAN, UTAH**

WHEREAS, The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program was enacted, and signed into law by President Gerald Ford, as the centerpiece of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974; and

WHEREAS, The CDBG program has as its primary objective "the development of viable urban communities, by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low and moderate income;" and

WHEREAS, The CDBG program has considerable flexibility to allow communities to carry out activities that are tailored to their unique affordable housing and neighborhood revitalization needs; and

WHEREAS, Throughout its 40-year history, the CDBG program has been a partnership among the federal, state and local governments, business, and the nonprofit sector which carry out activities that improve the lives and neighborhoods of low and moderate income families; and

WHEREAS, the **City of West Jordan** with CDBG funds in the approximate amount of \$6,836,000 since 1998 has provided for the construction of a Senior Citizen Center, park Improvements, street ADA ramps, housing improvements, public services, etc.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS PROCLAIMED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF WEST JORDAN, UTAH:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Council Members designate the Week of April 21 through April 26, 2014 as "**Community Development Block Grant Week**" in **West Jordan** in support of this valued program that has made a tremendous contribution to the viability of the housing stock, neighborhoods and infrastructure in West Jordan.

Section 2. That the West Jordan City Council and Mayor Kim V. Rolfe encourage all citizens to join together in expressing support for the Community Development Block Grant Program.

Section 3. This proclamation shall take effect immediately.
