WJFD Deputy Chief, Reed Scharman opened the meeting at 10:04am.

**Open Discussion**

Glen Jones asked that H<sub>2</sub>O be added to the response list for call outs for spills. The state had a list at some time with names, addresses, phone numbers etc. of companies for response and the level of their response ability and Glen would like to be added. Reed would like to have a list created so that if we have a spill the Fire Dept. can go contain the problem and then need to be able to turn it over to another company.

The State and West Jordan have split up some of the roads in West Jordan as far as how is responsible for them. For instance, the state is responsible for 9000 S., but the City takes care of 7800 S.

Chief Scharman shared about a situation that happened in West Jordan at the VASA Fitness Center. They had a Chlorine leak causing toxic levels of chlorine in the pool area to be in the water and air. They were able to get everyone out of the area, drain the water, and ventilate the air. They did have to call over to the water treatment plant to alert them due to the large drain of water that could hurt the bugs at the treatment.

Chuck with SVWRF said due to the chemicals this incident caused his company to change their policies for pretreatment inspectors to check pools for drain systems etc.

In preparation for large scale problems, WJFD has done a video in collaboration with the Jordan School District for reunification of children to parents.
