

What do you think about the proposed Jordan River Parkway Trail connection?

The City of West Jordan is proposing to construct a new segment of the Jordan River Parkway Trail, approximately 1.37 miles in length, between approximately 8230 South and 9000 South. The proposed trail alignment would cross lands owned by the United States under the jurisdiction of the Utah Reclamation Mitigation and Conservation Commission. The City has requested an easement from the Mitigation Commission allowing for the construction of the trail on the lands owned by the United States. A Draft Environmental Assessment disclosing the anticipated environmental impacts of the proposed project has been prepared and you are invited to comment.
