**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE
JORDAN SCHOOL DISTRICT \$245 MILLION BOND**

WHEREAS, the City of West Jordan and Jordan School District have entered into an inter-local agreement to support each other; and

WHEREAS, Jordan School District serves more than 52,300 children living in West Jordan, Bluffdale, Copperton, Herriman, Riverton, and South Jordan; and

WHEREAS, 9,251 new students are projected to enroll in the District by 2021-22; and

WHEREAS, the District proposes to rebuild West Jordan Middle school; and

WHEREAS, the District proposes to build 6 new schools; and

WHEREAS, the District proposes a bond in the amount of \$245 million; and

WHEREAS, the average homeowner will pay \$16.80 per year for said bond; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Jordan believes the Jordan School District proposed bond is in the best interests of the citizens and residents within West Jordan and the District boundaries.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST JORDAN, UTAH, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of West Jordan hereby express their support for the Jordan School District \$245 million Bond.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
