



**Ballots that were delivered in the morning, by the Post Office are placed in this locked cage until two employees can begin the signature verification process.**



**After signature verification the ballots are sorted into boxes that need further review or issues resolved.**



**This was the stack of ballots that had issues (i.e., signatures, two ballots in one envelope, or no ballot, etc.) that had been cleared up on Tuesday, July 30.**



**Ballots are separated from the envelope. As you can see the stack of envelopes are zip tied and count must match the count of ballots. She is unfolding the ballots and placing in a 'good' pile and a pile that needs to be 'enhanced' or duplicated.**



**In the same room she is reviewing each ballot for clarity, enhancing the ones that need enhancing, and counting the number of ballots that will be placed in the box to her left, with the batch label placed on top.**



**These are a few of West Jordan's boxes, with ballots that have not been tabulated. As you will see, there are always two signatures to verify the count, locked in a secure room, waiting for tabulation.**
